IPHA PAN:

Agenda 4:- Presentation and review of the audited statement of accounts.

The Secretary General presented the audited statement of the last financial year. The financial statement was prepared last 9 months, i.e., from January 2016 to December 2016, as it was decided earlier that financial statement will be prepared as per the calendar year. The statement was approved at the CC.

Secretary General put forward the estimated cost for the forthcoming year. It was accepted.

Agenda 6: Proposal for appointment of Auditors.

Secretary General informed that there is a need to review the continuation of current audit firm due to higher financial charges. She put forwarded one firm has already approached IPHA. Financial Committee along with Secretary General will look into the proposal and take appropriate measures.

Agenda 7: Discussion regarding the next Annual Conference.

The Secretary General informed that four proposals have come so far to the HQ, KGMU Lucknow, OMC Hyderabad, AIIMS Delhi, Medical College Goa for hosting the next Annual Conference, Proposal has

come from Prof. V.K. Srivastava from KGMU, Lucknow has been accepted by Central Council and the proposal is sent to AGB for concurrence.

Agenda 8: IJPH related issues.

The editor and managing editor informed the CC that timely publication and dispatch of issues has been a priority to the editorial board. All the four issues in 2016 have been published on time. First issue of 2017 is also in the process of printing. They also updated the CC about the current status of publications.
